2012 On-line Registration Now Open!

The proforma orders (essentially a digital copy of the preprinted membership forms) **have been generated by GSUSA!** You will be able to renew **2012 membership registration on-line** via Ebiz, but girls or adults that you have not yet registered for 2011 will have to be processed via paper registrations **forms**.

Now that we can re-register for 2012 on-line, the "add girl" and "add adult" buttons have been taken down. Any girls or adults that you have not yet registered for 2011 will need to be processed by "paper registrations" (Hard copies of GS reg. form).

The National Young Women of Distinction (NYWOD) are chosen from among those Gold Award recipients whose final projects demonstrated extraordinary leadership, addressed a local challenge that related to a national and/or global issue, and had a measurable and sustainable impact.

Girl Scouts who receive the NYWOD honor will receive a \$3,000 college scholarship made possible through the generosity of the Ford Foundation and Kappa Delta.
